NOTICE TO NEW YORK APPLICANTS:

"Any person who knowingly and with intent to defraud any insurance company, or other person files an application for insurance or statement of claim containing any materially false information, or conceals for the purpose of misleading, information concerning any fact material thereto, commits a fraudulent insurance act, which is a crime and shall also be subject to civil penalty not to exceed Five Thousand Dollars and the stated value of the claim for each such violation."

NOTICE TO OHIO APPLICANTS:

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CLIMBING WALL GUIDELINES

The following are suggested guidelines:

The wall itself must be described on the application as to how it is constructed, what type of hand holds are used. The attachments for attaching the hand holds must be described, if bolts, include size and grade. The belay anchoring points must be provided. The belay points and top rope anchor points need to have a redundant fail safe back-up system and a minimum strength as the OSHA requirements for restraint device which is 5400 pounds. The whole structural system shall be certified by an engineer as to its structural soundness so as not to collapse on the participants or bystanders.

The ground surface under the climbing wall base shall extend from the wall surface to at least six feet (Eight feet with walls over twenty feet). All ground surfaces shall be of one of the following types:

1. a minimum of four inches of rubber covered athletic tumbling mat;
2. uniform gravel, round half inch minus at a minimum depth no less than twelve inches;
3. twelve inches shaved and shredded rubber tires.

The method of training belayers must be described including the number of hours or the number of belays observed required for belayers to be approved.

A record keeping system must be used to record and keep track of climbers and belayers. All climbers, belayers and users must sign a release, including acknowledgment of all hazards. Helmets must be worn by all students and is recommended to be worn by everyone.

On site manager or his replacement shall be on duty at all times that the wall is being used. Their duties shall be described in the operations manual. The manual shall include rescue procedures for someone hung up after falling.

A method of securing climbing wall to prevent climbing during unattended time shall be provided.

The manual shall include conditions under which non-topped roped non-belayed climbing will be allowed and to what height. Recommended no higher than shoulder height of spotter, six feet and the wall so marked.

The number of rental helmets or free gratis helmets available to be disclosed in the application. Any additional or other equipment furnished such as shoes, harness, etc. to be listed and described. Type of tie-in to be described and listed, for example, figure 8 retrace with half prussic safety knot. Description of all facilities at center to be included in outline manual.
