NOTICE TO NEW YORK APPLICANTS:

"Any person who knowingly and with intent to defraud any insurance company, or other person files an application for insurance or statement of claim containing any materially false information, or conceals for the purpose of misleading, information concerning any fact material thereto, commits a fraudulent insurance act, which is a crime and shall also be subject to civil penalty not to exceed Five Thousand Dollars and the stated value of the claim for each such violation."

NOTICE TO OHIO APPLICANTS:

"Any person who, with intent to defraud or knowing that he is facilitating a fraud against an insurer, submits an application or files a claim containing a false or deceptive statement is guilty of insurance fraud."

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CONCERTS

The following are suggested guidelines:

1. Provisions shall be provided (i.e. fence barricade) to control participants getting to and especially from the show.
2. A complete operations manual shall have a written plan and this plan shall be implemented for each of the shows. The plan shall provide for security, first aid and special evacuation procedures for the sick or injured. Also the plan shall provide for va
3. If the show runs after dark, proper lighting shall be provided to and in the parking area(s).
4. The entire show shall be coordinated with the local law enforcement and fire departments. This includes any special permits required for local and state authorities.
