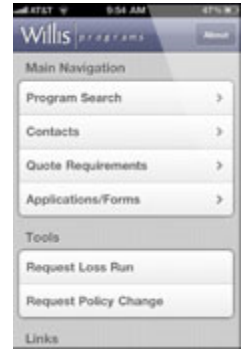



Willis Programs Web App

Our mobile website is accessible from all phones with internet connectivity. Connect to the Willis Programs app by going directly to www.willisprograms.com/webapp from your mobile device. Once you are on the site you can add the site to your bookmarks or home screen for faster access to our programs mobile site. For guidance, we have included instructions below.



iPhone/iPad:

- Open your browser on your iPhone/iPad. Once you've opened your browser, type www.willisprograms.com/webapp into the address field and let the page fully load.
- Once the page has loaded, click on the  button (or + button on some versions).
- A screen should pop up which will allow you to save the website to your home screen.
- Tap 'Add to Home Screen'.
- Your iPhone/iPad will ask you to give your new app a name and then tap 'Add'.
- The Willis Programs icon should now be on your home screen.
- You can now access the Willis Programs mobile site with the touch of a button.



Android:

- Open your browser on your phone. Once you've opened your browser, type www.willisprograms.com/webapp into the address field and let the page fully load.

- Once the page has loaded, click your menu button and click 'bookmarks' and then click 'add'.
- Go to home screen and press-and-hold (in an empty space) to bring up the menu and select 'shortcut', then select 'bookmark' and lastly select the Willis Programs bookmark.
- The Willis Programs icon should now be on your home screen. (Depending on the version of your phone, your icon may appear differently).
- You can now access the Willis Programs mobile site with the touch of a button.



Other Smart Phones:

- Open your browser on your phone. Once you've opened your browser, type www.willisprograms.com/webapp into the address field and let the page fully load.
- Once the page has loaded, click your menu button on your phone and from here, you should be able to add the site to your bookmarks for quick and easy access.
- Depending on your phone, you might be able to then add a shortcut of the Willis Programs bookmark to your home screen.
